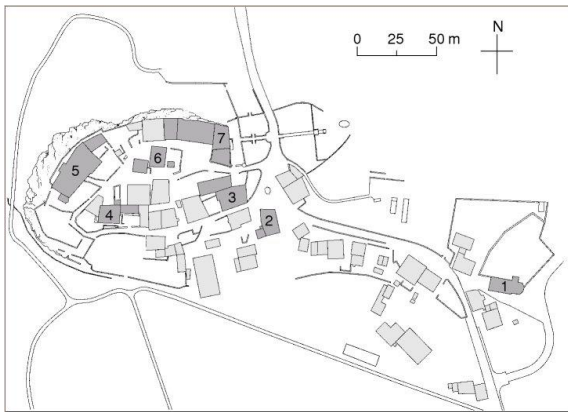


Garden with swimming pool

Chur and Art Museum

Viamala Canyon

The Viamala is legendary. An impressive natural monument with rock walls up to 300 m high, which are only a few metres apart at the narrowest points. The play of colours of the water, the whirlpools and the rock formations leave a strong impression of natural beauty.



Rhine Gorge Ruinaulta the Grand Canyon of Switzerland

The Rhine Gorge between Reichenau and Ilanz is not called "Swiss Grand Canyon" for nothing.

In the wild gorges you can experience pure adrenaline during river rafting or you can hike along rugged rock formations.



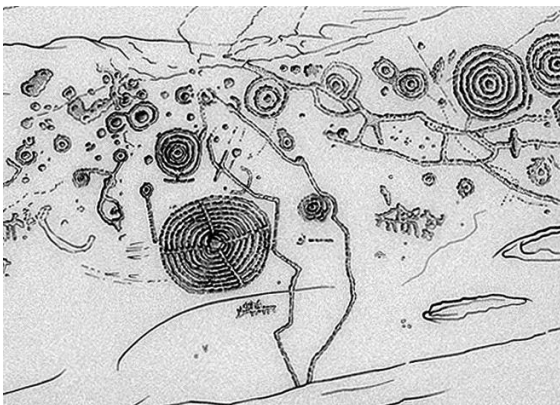
Lake Cauma to Conn

A little summer feeling - then you've come to the right place! At Lake Cauma you can relax. Be it a refreshing bath or a walk of about 40 minutes in the direction of the restaurant Conn.



Waterway Hiking in Flims

The award-winning Flims waterway takes you from the source of the Flem stream in the upper Segnesboden through unique gorge landscapes to the centre of Flims. It crosses seven bridges, some of them boldly built by the famous Grisons bridge builder Jürg Conzett.



Carschenna Rock Drawings

The greatest secret of the area around the Viamala gorge is undoubtedly the petroglyphs of Carschenna, where 11 slabs of rock are covered with drawings.

Despite its small size, this site is one of the most important of its kind in Switzerland. The figures, symbols, signs and lines, the bowls, circles and spirals can neither be dated nor interpreted.



Church in Zillis

The Romanesque ceiling is world-famous. She made the church of St. Martin the "Sixtina of the Alps".
